Following the performance at the Gusman Center, guests will move to the Alfred I. Dupont Building for the gala portion of the evening. The party begins with a cocktail reception, wine and cruise silent auction, and a drawing featuring a dazzling variety of luxury items and experiences. During the reception, guests will be surrounded by vignettes with incredible performances by the 2010 YoungArts finalists. Immediately following is a seated dinner.
